The new CND mission in Meyomessala

It was 16th September 2014, during a Eucharistic celebration, in the Regional chapel that Evangeline, Brigitte and Justine received their obedience "**...to start a new mission in Meyomessala**"

Meyomessala, populated village, is situated in the South Cameroon, approximately at 300km from Yaoundé, 45km from Sangmelima and 3Km from Mvomeka.

In order to promote the Evangelization through the spirituality of Visitation and Pentecost, the CND sisters plan to build a school. In addition, they will exploit a 10 hectares plantation which has been entrusted by the Bishop of Sangmélina Archbishop Christophe Zoa.

In the picture above, you can see the construction site of the future school. The series of buildings (indicated by red arrows) that can be seen a little further will shelter dozens of families in a few months. Opposite the site is St Simon the chapel (see joined picture).
